## **Bulletin Reflection**

Dan 12:1-3 The splendid resurrection of the just is announced

Heb 10:11-14,18 Jesus' offering of himself as a sacrifice for sin perfects those who are being sanctified. No further offering is needed.

Mark 13:24-32 Severe trials of every sort precedes the coming of the Son of Man. As to the exact day or hour, no one knows not, not even the Son but only the father

The church year is quickly coming to a close. Advent will begin a new year, ecclesiastically and liturgically, as we begin preparations for the new birth of Jesus, while next Sunday, the final one of the "old" year, celebrates gloriously

the Kingship of Jesus over our entire lives. In fact our planet earth and all peoples, this Sunday's readings provide a more tranquil setting for meditation.

The references to the resurrection of the just in the Book of Daniel to Jesus' perfect offering of Himself for sin in the second reading from Hebrew and finally to the second coming of Jesus in the Gospel-all reminds us that we become an entirely new, transformed person at the end. In other words we enter Heaven, innocent with all our sins forgiven, linked with the assembly of God's "chosen" from the four winds, from the farthest bounds of earth and sky.
