## REFLECTION

Passion or Palm Sunday- Sixth Sunday of Lent: Year C

Luke 19:28-40. (Gospel for the procession) Luke's account of Jesus' messianic entry into Jerusalem heightens the struggle which Jesus will face in the city and temple, and announces the final destruction of the Holy City, especially in the fuller account in Luke 19: 28-40.

Is 50: 4-7. In the prophecy of Isaiah the third song of the suffering servant combines attentive listening and abject humiliation with dignified strength.

Phil (2: 6-11.) Jesus emptied himself of his divine dignity to be incarnated in our midst and suffer the humiliation of the cross, as a way to glory and divine exaltation.

Luke 22: 14-23:56. The passion according to Luke portrays Jesus more frequently than the other gospels in prayer, in forgiveness, in concern for others and attracting them to follow, even to take up His cross like Simon of Cyrene.


