BULLETIN REFLECTION

REFLECTION

The three readings of today invite us to reflect on the meaning of the Eucharist and tell us that it is nourishment. It is not a medicine that act automatically, it must be received with faith, that is by accepting the commitment that the act of eating and drinking the body and blood of Christ entails. All the three readings insist on the close link between the Eucharist and life; between the Bread that is Christ and the bread that nourishes the body. One cannot be in Communion with the Body of the Lord without sharing the material bread with the brother. That is clearly shown in the first reading and the Gospel. The second reading stresses mainly the incompatibility between the "breaking of bread" and the dissensions and divisions in the community. What we eat is the Body and Blood of Christ which purifies and nourishes our soul.


