Reflection

(Isaiah 53:10-11) Through his suffering my servant shall justify many and their guilt he shall bear.

(Heb 4:14-15) We confidently approach the throne of God's grace where Jesus has entered, Jesus who is able to sympathise with our weakness as he was tempted in every way that we are, without sinning.

(Mark 10:35-45) Anyone who aspires to greatness must serve the rest whoever wants to rank first must serve the needs of all.

The bible again demonstrates its uncanny (a better word would be its divine or inspired) way of blending the natural with the supernatural, leadership with others who are being led, humility and healthy aspirations. As happens often enough with Sunday readings, the first and the Gospel selection closely parallel one another, even to the point of having more explanation about the word of God.

Isaiah's remarks about a suffering servant of the Lord is applied by Jesus to Himself.

He gives his life as an offering for

sin (Isa 53:10) The son of man has

come to give his life in ransom

for the many (Mark 10:45) It is a clarion call for us to look inwardly into ourselves and see a way to make amendment of our lives through this particular passage of Mark's Gospel
