BULLETIN REFLECTION

REFLECTION

Pentecost: is a Christian feast on the Seventh Sunday after Easter Commemorating the decent of the Holy Spirit on the apostles called White Sunday:

It is a major Chistian feast on the Seventh Sunday after Easter observed as a Christian Church festival in memory of the appearance of the Holy Spirit on the apostles of Jesus Christ, however, the first reading and the Gospel present the decent of the Spirit. It is the same event presented differently. The stories of Luke and John complement each other and teach us that the Spirit is the New Law. The force that leads Mankind to do good from within the heart because it energizes and empowers one to do the right thing always. The spirit is the source of unity (it pulls down all barriers) and whenever it arrives it destroys sin. That is the Spirit Jesus promised to each member of His church. (Jn 14:16-20)

May we all pray that this Spirit will come upon us and renew the face of the earth, so that in our world today we will have peace, love and above all mutual relation.


