1Kg 17:10-16, A widow of Zarephath is willing to share her last food with Elijah and is rewarded with a continued supply until the draught ended

Heb 9:24-28, Christ has entered the heavenly sanctuary to appear before God on our behalf. He will come to earth a second time to bring final salvation

Mark 12:38-44, unlike the ostentatious scribes and wealthy donors, the widow unobtrusively gives all that she possesses two small copper coins. When we give away the last of our possessions, we give ourselves away. There is nothing left, even of life. The words of the widow of Zarephath come to mind; I have left, only a handful of flour... and a little oil...

when we have eaten it, we shall die ... while the widow in the Gospel acts silently, her actions are interpreted for us by Jesus. She gave... all that she had to live on. We look forward for a profound radical change in our way of giving after such actions, which reach into the roots of our life, our life can never remain the same, there will be a multiplication of Gods blessings (1) the jar of flour shall not go empty, nor the jug of oil run dry until the day that the lord sends rain upon the earth, this proclamation shall be ours in Jesus name, Amen.
