## **Reflection**

## **Bulletin Reflection**

Dan 7:13-14 The Son of man, coming on the clouds, receives our everlasting Kingdom, with nations and peoples of every language serving Him.

Rev 1:5-8 Jesus Christ comes amid the clouds. Every eye shall see Him, even of those who pierced Him. He loves us and has freed us of our sins by His Blood.

John 18: 33-37 My Kingdom, says Jesus, does not belong to this World. Anyone committed to the truth hears my voice.

As mentioned last week we are at the end of one church year, about to begin a new Church year with Advent. The solemnity of Christ the King enable us, peacefully to confide

our preceding year into the hands of God. Hopefully and more wisely to look ahead. The biblical readings guide us in this process. The book of Daniel locates us towards the end of a terrifying persecution. (167 -165 BC); the gospel reading from the Passion narrative, in the final moments of Jesus' earthly life. Once again, the second or middle reading provides a different viewpoint and opens up a fresh insight for us. The book of Revelation inaugurates a new transforming moment for the Son of man and for the World. In fact, the book opens with the urgent announcement "the revelation of what must happen very soon"
