Baruch 5:1-9. The Glory breaks over the new Jerusalem and God's people return to their homeland.

Phil 1:4-6, 8-11. Paul prays for the completion of God's holiness and charity among these, his favourite converts.

LK 3: 1-6. John the Baptist is introduced amidst the data of world history

The return from exile becomes a spiritual journey from discouragement and spiritual meditation upon the sacred traditions enables the author to sustain hope and to find a rich value in the life that was otherwise the best. The quiet but heavy-hearted style of Baruch relaxes in Paul's letter to the Philippians. The warm, pervasive joy extends over the returning of the Israel from Exile. The two readings including the Gospel emphasizes on the peace.
